

Action Points/Decisions from NIFF meeting via Teams held on 30.09.2020

1. Election of NIFF chair and Vice Chair

It was decided at the last NIFF meeting held on the 22nd September 2020 that a stand-alone meeting would be held to elect the new Chair and Vice Chair of the NIFF. A discussion took place on rotating the position of NIFF Chair and Vice Chair every 6 months to share the workload amongst the members and give everyone an opportunity to gain experience of acting as the Chair/Vice Chair. The NIFF members agreed with the proposal of a rotating Chair/Vice Chair.

Action Points/Decisions: a.) Eamon Dixon acting NIFF chair elected as full NIFF chair until the end of December 2020 completing a six-month term he started in July 2020. New NIFF chair to be elected by the beginning of December for the next term from the 1st January to the 30 June 2021 b.) Bernard Whelan elected as NIFF Vice Chair for a six-month term ending on the 31st March 2021. John Menarry to take on role as NIFF Vice Chair from the 1st April 2020 for a six-month term. c.) NIFF secretary to send on updated committees list to NIFF members to fill vacant and alternate positions. A short CV from each member was suggested outlining their strengths so that NIFF work could be divided up appropriately. d.) Discussion documents as outlined at the NIFF meeting on the 22nd September to be completed and forwarded to NIFF secretary asap to circulate to the NIFF members to prepare an agenda for the possible meeting with the Minister.
