#### 3. Project objectives

a) To undertake a 'map and gap' analysis of small-scale fishers' representation in each Member State

- Geographically
- Numbers of vessels
- Gear types / metiers
- Numbers of members / numbers of fishermen
- Annual production (by species if possible)
- Staffing (employed staff Y/N?)
- Funding arrangements in place
- Affiliations to other National organisations
- Communication channels used (web, phone, e-mail, paper)





#### 3. Project objectives

b) Identify what issues are faced and where decision-making needs to be influenced

- Local / regional management
- National management
- EU management
- Allocation of resources (quota, effort or areas)
- Local harbour issues
- Marketing and trade (e.g. co-ops)
- Gear conflict / co-management
- Others (e.g. marine renewables, aggregates, oil & gas)





#### 3. Project objectives

c) Understand barriers to engagement

- Lack of human resource capacity
- Lack of funding
- Poor organisational structure / internal communication
- Unrealistic expectations of members (poor understanding of processes?)
- Lack of allies / political support
- Disagreement with others bodies (potential partners)

- d) Identify best practice
  - Communication (internally and externally)
  - Engagement (internally and externally)
  - Representation
  - Organisational structure (formal / legal)
  - Use of funding (e.g. EMFF, Interreg)
